Building confidence

Aged 17, Maisie had been referred to Ride High by the NHS Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services.

Maisie had experienced domestic violence and her father was in prison. She had become so anxious that she couldn't be left alone or attend school.

When Maisie first joined Ride High, she was unable to visit without her mother's support. Her high anxiety meant that she couldn't go to the toilet alone and she found it difficult to mix with other children.

As time progressed, Maisie's confidence grew and her attitude and behaviour towards others improved. She became welcoming, friendly and supportive to the fellow members of her group. She felt ready to leave her mum at home and came to sessions alone. In her last half term she went onto lead a clubroom session on e-safety.

Maisie attended Ride High for ten months. By the time she left she had started a course at college and was working part time. She was barely recognisable from the person we met when she first joined the programme.

Helping Natalie to smile again

Natalie joined Ride High in March last year. Natalie's mum, her sole carer had been very poorly and had spent a great deal of time in hospital. Natalie was living with family members and had stopped attending school. She suffered with intense anxiety, had refused counselling and was receiving no specialist support.

Natalie was withdrawn when she joined Ride High and hardly spoke. Gradually over six months the warmth, fun and friendship in her group helped her to relax. She formed a bond with her Club Leader which made her to feel safe and her true personality began to shine.

Since then Natalie's confidence has continued to grow. Ride High have supported her as she moved



into a new home with her mum and she has settled into a new place at school. We're delighted that Natalie is now an ambassador for Ride High and attended our tenth anniversary ball this year.
