Poppy's passion

Poppy is 17. She was referred to Ride High with severe anxiety and a fear of leaving the house, which has resulted in her not being able to go to school now for about four years.

After some time on our waiting list Poppy joined our Portfolio group in January. Unsurprisingly quiet and awkward in a new setting to start, it was clear early on that Poppy found great comfort in being with the horses, and she progressed quickly with her riding and groundwork.

Currently half-way through her course, you'll often find Poppy grooming on the yard with a beaming smile on her face. She talks openly to visitors about how she loves the responsibility of looking after the horses, and that being trusted to care for the horses boosts her confidence. The way Poppy interacts with people she's never met before, and other members of her group is quite remarkable and illustrates how far she's come in such a short time. But this is just the beginning of Poppy's journey. Armed with her new-found skills and confidence she's looking to the future and has applied to an Equine Management course at Moulton College. She took her Ride High portfolio with her to her interview to evidence her commitment and abilities, and we're delighted that she's been offered a place to start in September!

On the last week of term before Easter, Poppy's dad came to watch her ride. She was so proud to show him what she could do, and he was visibly moved by the change in her. Speaking to dad he told us how Ride High has ignited a passion within Poppy and empowered her to look to the future and not let her anxieties get in the way.

Over the next few months we'll continue to support Poppy and we can't wait to see her go from strength to strength.
