

## **VOLUNTEER SURVEY RESULTS 2023**

We greatly appreciate the support of our dedicated volunteers who week-in week-out give their time to support our sessions with the children. We could not possibly achieve what we do without you.

We are continually working to strengthen our Volunteering Programme and to ensure that all our volunteers find their Ride High experience rewarding and enjoyable.

This year we decided to launch a survey to seek feedback from our volunteers to identify where we can make improvements - this will become an annual survey for which we will share the results and our plans to act on them with all volunteers. This, our first survey was completed by 25 volunteers.

## How clearly was your volunteer position and responsibilities explained to you?



- Extremely clearly 40%
- Very clearly 52%
- Neutral 4%
- Very unclearly 4%
- Extremely unclearly 0%

## After induction how prepared did you feel to meet your volunteer responsibilities?



- Extremely prepared 32%
- Very prepared 56%
- Neutral 12%
- Very unprepared 0%
- Extremely unprepared 0%

## Suggestions for improving the induction process



"Improved induction to the horses/riding element".

"Clearer instruction about what to wear - including equipment i.e. helmet ".

"Clarification on clubroom responsibilities and whose doing what".

"Would like introduction to equestrian centre staff".

"More instructions on what actions to take if something goes wrong around the horses".

We were pleased that on the whole volunteers felt they had a clear understanding about their responsibilities before starting at Ride High. However we recognise that there is room for improvement.



Actions we've already taken to support progress are 1) to create a Volunteer Handbook which will act as a reference guide for all volunteers, and 2) to offer extra training sessions with the horses for those with less equine experience.
