Breaking Boundaries



Melody is 17 and joined Ride High back in September after being referred by her social worker. Melody suffers with social anxiety and her autism which means she has always struggled to make friends. She prefers to stay at home in her safe space than go out and meet new people, meaning she often feels isolated. Melody loves animals, and after completing work experience at an equestrian centre her social worker thought Ride High would be a programme she would find engaging. Melody shared with us how Ride High has already had an impact on her life after just 7 weeks.

"Ride High has helped me so much and has given me a reason to get out of bed in the morning; it has given me something to feel excited about again. My highlight so far was seeing Smartie (pictured) for the first time and knowing in my heart I wanted to ride him. When riding I feel so much more confident in myself. I feel calm when I'm here, all my problems go away and I just focus on the horses and forget about everything else. Ride High has been life-changing already, everyone here is so different but it means you can learn from each other. Ride High has taught me to step out of my comfort zone and that if I don't try and push myself I will never get anywhere."

Melody starts college this month with the dream to work at a nursery helping young children. We are so proud that Ride High has improved Melody's confidence in such a short amount of time and has helped her feel excited about the next step and what the future holds. We look forward to seeing her continue to grow in the coming weeks at Ride High.
